WHAT HAPPENS THE MOMENT AFTER YOU DIE?

Every reader needs to acknowledge that every single day over 200,000 people will take their final breath, and slip into **eternity**.

The Bible says that "The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life."

Are **you** ready???

I am in hours of prayer and thought, standing in the gap, reaching out to God for the souls of all my siblings, the siblings of my wife, and for the new souls that will enter into our world.

Yes, every day over 200,000 people will begin the **first day of eternity**. The question is WHERE will they begin Eternity?

Though their lives may never make headlines or be in the news, the reality of death takes place every day.

I ASK EVERY READER, all the members of my own family and of my wife's family, all of my friends and acquaintances; do you really understand that this life on this earth is but one little second long in comparison to eternity? Let's take a little walk while we see what really happens when your soul leaves your body. Where is your spirit that God loaned you going to be FOREVER AND FOREVER AND FOREVER?? I hold my wife Josie's hand daily and at night as we pray for every one of our family members, relatives, and friends that God will convict us of all spots and blemishes that we may knowingly or unknowingly have, and that none of us will miss that glorious day of the soon return of our Lord Jesus Christ. This event will begin eternity for everyone who is alive.

This book, *Where Will the People You Meet Spend Eternity?* will teach every reader what every believer can do and should do to help bring 6.4 Billion souls to Eternity in Heaven.

Let us proceed to the truth of what the future holds for each and every person born in this world.

Let me help you answer the question,

"What happens the moment after you die?"

Those who put their **faith in Christ** will be in the **presence of God.** They will be surrounded with many loved ones and with friends who are believers that they have known on this earth.

Unbelievers will be engulfed in darkness, but they should be fully aware of their state. Scenes and images and sinful acts of their life on this earth will be played back in their memory. These memories will torment their soul of opportunities they lost and the wrongs they did. They will cry and want to be back with their family and friends. But it is too late to change circumstances.

Unless prearrangements have been made by you, your loved ones will plan your funeral. They will decide on a casket, and take care of the details in the write-up of your obituary. Meanwhile, your body remains silent, oblivious to the confusion.

Although you are unable to communicate with them, your soul and your spirit will be more alive than they have ever been.

The preacher will be called, and your relatives and friends will come to be with your immediate family. Pallbearers carry your lifeless body to its final resting place. Words of comfort are offered as they lower your body into the ground. Dust to dust you shall return, while your body awaits the Resurrection for the final call to eternity and your destiny.

Mourners offer their condolences, by placing roses, carnations, or other flowers on the newly-tilled ground. They embrace one another turning away in their grief, with tears holding onto the precious memories of their departed loved one.

Although the unbeliever's body remains resting... Who can fathom the depths and pain, anguish and agony of the hell he is experiencing? **His spirit screams as Hell** from beneath is moved to meet him at his coming. Sad to say, but he was unprepared to meet God who created him.

Though he cries in his torment his prayer has no value whatsoever, for a great gulf and valley exists which separates Heaven and Hell.

Hopelessly, he stares at the awfulness and irreparable condition of his state. The beautiful words spoken in his **eulogy** bear no resemblance to the reality and the truth that he now faces. Words and prayer cannot change this dreadful state. If only his loved ones could see him now, in his horror beyond all human imagination.

A moment after you die you will see with clarity that the choice and decision that you made of your very own free will, will be honored throughout eternity.

Though the unbeliever's natural body lays resting in the casket, their spirit screams out to their loved ones to avoid this place. He begs them to repent from their sinful ways, from disobedience, and from their separation with God. In torment, he awaits the final judgment, where his body and soul, will be cast into the **Lake of Fire.** They have turned their hardened heart away from God. They have not said "Yes" to Jesus, the Gift of God for eternal life. The unbeliever's death is great loss. The flame of hope is forever extinguished of ever seeing their loved ones again. They are left alone in their misery and they are alone in their memories.

The weight of their guilt is indescribable. Who can measure the depth of their agony?

On the contrary, the death of the saints is precious reunion with God.

Though he walks through the **valley of the shadow of death**, he will fear no evil, for his confidence is in the Lord and the Lord is with him. Though fear may lurk from every side, **he is not afraid**, because he knows that he is ready to be with our Master, The Lord Jesus Christ. His **hand** is in the hand of **his Loving Shepherd**, **the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords**, **Jesus Christ the Son of the Living God**, all because he has confessed and received Jesus Christ as Lord of his Life. He has surrendered to Him, He has yielded to him, and he has submitted to him, he has COMMITTED his life to Him 100% and has been "born again." The Lord is He who will **take him safely** Home **to the other side**.

The believer's death is great gain, not pain! Escorted by the angels into the presence of God, the believer is now comforted. Their trials, pains, sorrows and suffering are all past. Though their presence will be dearly missed, yet they have hope, knowing that they'll be reunited in Glory, with their loved ones in Christ. For those who put their faith in Christ, death is but a doorway that opens into Eternal Life.

The survivor shared how Reverend Harper gave him his own life jacket as he (the survivor) received Jesus Christ and was saved.

He watched John Harper as he slipped down into the ice cold water in to eternity.

Tonight, there is a great meeting and outcry in Hell. **Souls are crying** out for their **lost brothers, sisters, children, family and friends...** that someone would tell their families, so they won't come to this horrible place of torment. (Luke 16:27)

I speak on behalf of those who died without Christ. I plead with you to hear the tears in their voice. There's **more concern** about your **soul in Hell** than anywhere else tonight.

Oh, if only we could hear and see those who missed it. It would move our hearts to warn others of the reality of Hell. How different their decision would have been **if someone would** have told them, as I tell you tonight, my friend.

There is a Day of Judgment coming where we will stand before God, transparent. He will not compare our life with the lives of others, but rather against His Holy perfection. Are your sins under the blood of our Lord Jesus who died on the cross for you?

Search your heart, dear reader. Are there particular sins that you know need to be dealt with, sins that you try to hide? Are there old skeletons in your closet? Take a moment, and confess them to God. The Lord Jesus is just and willing to forgive you.

Lie across your bed; kneel by your chair or your couch, and begin to let the tears flow as you admit all your sins and all your mistakes one by one. *A broken and contrite heart, O God will not despise.* (Psalm 51:17)

You can begin a new relationship free of all sin with Him right now by praying a simple prayer such as the following:





Soul-winning in the Marketplace... It's a Piece of Cake!

- A. People are so hungry for God's power to touch their lives.
 - a. STOP and listen to God and the cry from almost everyone you meet, begging, "Please pass me the Gospel! I am stressed out and full of anxiety."
 - b. God is never in a hurry, but He's always right on time!
 - c. Are you willing to be led by the Holy Spirit?
 - d. Are you willing to be available to God to be used for the greatest adventure of all time – winning souls to Jesus?
- B. I studied great men of God, and learned something about being simple.
 - a. I learned two important keys:
 - i. The first one is obedience to what God tells you to do.
 - ii. Secondly, you must use the Word of God to share with others.
 - 1. The Word discerns the heart, the mind, and the thoughts of the person with whom you are speaking, and knows what they are thinking.
 - 2. So, why would we want to do the talking when we can permit God to talk through our own lips through using Scriptures which is God's voice?
- C. Jesus Christ gave us a Helper, His Holy Spirit
 - a. The Holy Ghost came to fill us with power to be His witnesses.

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Acts 1:8

D. As I unfold the steps to effective soul-winning to you, you're going to say, "That's simple. I can do that with my eyes closed!"



- a. Speak out loud right now, "Winning souls is a piece of cake!"
- b. Everyone is a minister that includes YOU! Say, "That includes me!"
- c. Listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit. He will guide you where to go and what to say.
- d. The Holy Spirit will convict people of their need for a Savior.
- E. God gave me a miracle formula for winning the entire world.
 - a. If you get 10,000 Christian believers who are winning just three souls a month – less than one soul a week – that's a good

goal to set! In three years and three months, 10,000 Christians can win 6.4 billion souls!

- b. Change your perspective: Your life is less than one second long on this earth in comparison to eternity!
- F. God uses us in different stages. Therefore, don't think that you always have to do it all! You may be just a beginner in something, planting a seed, or perhaps watering it as well. Others may take the harvest.
 - a. Each person has their own gift from God.
 - b. Be content and happy about how God uses you, and don't try to be like someone else.
- G. Opportunities to win souls are everywhere. Here is an illustration:

On my way to preach a revival in Arkansas, I was getting my shoes shined at the airport. I said to the man who was shining my shoes, "I'd like to ask you a question."

He answered back, "What is it?" I could tell he was Hispanic so I spoke to him in Spanish. "Do you believe there's a God in Heaven?"

"Oh, yes I do," was his answer.

"Do you believe there's a Heaven or a Hell?"

Again, he answered in the affirmative, "Oh, sure."

I said, "Do you believe there is a devil?"

"Well yes, I guess so."

So, then I asked," Well, tell me, where would you like to go - to Heaven or to Hell?" That's a pretty easy one to ask and a fairly easy question to answer, isn't it?

"I'd like to go to Heaven, of course!" he answered quickly.

I continued encouraging him on with rhetorical questions, "Would you like to know how you may know and be very sure you're ready to go?"

"Yes, of course," he said. "I want to be sure."

Friend, say, "That's a simple one – Heaven or Hell?" I began to share about eight or nine Scriptures with him on salvation – the Word! Don't argue about theology, and don't argue about ideology or religion. Once they get saved, the Holy Spirit will start convicting their hearts regarding what's true. Remember, don't get into religious arguments – just get them saved! So, step by step, I shared a few select Scriptures on salvation, and the Holy Spirit convicted him.

He said the sinner's prayer with tears in his eyes and said, "I've got to show you something. I've been studying." He pulled out a little Gideon's Bible that someone had given him just that week. He was full of interest and questions before I got there. See, someone had already planted the seed. I came along, watered the seed, and harvested it!

So, How Do I Go About Winning Souls? Practical Suggestions and More Examples

- A. An example of witnessing to someone about Christ:
 - a. Get into the Scriptures which penetrate their heart.
 - b. I usually like to start by saying, "You know, God is not a religion. He is not a church. God is a relationship."
 - c. You start by getting their guard down. You say, "We're not talking about a certain church; we're talking about your getting the assurance that you're going to make it to Heaven. Is that okay?"
 - i. "Oh yeah, that's great," is the usual response.
 - d. Then, you begin to tell them, "The Bible says... the Word of God says... Jesus says..." (Stick to using the Word.) Then, you quote them a Scripture, like 1 Timothy 2:5. "Jim, Betty, Susie, or whoever you are speaking with, the Bible says in 1 Timothy 2:5: For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.
 - i. NOTE: You will find a list of suggested Scriptures on the last page and inside back cover of this syllabus.
 - e. Then, I like to ask them, "Do you know Who God's Son is?"
 - i. "Sure. It's Jesus, isn't it?" (They usually respond.) If they seem a little unsure or hesitant, shake your head in an affirmative direction. Give them a little help.

 Gesture in a positive way. It gives them confidence to answer
 - f. I restate this by repeating, "...one mediator between God and man," and then take them over to John 14:6. You can start with verses one through six:

Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way? Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. (John 14:6)

- i. Don't tell people, they have the wrong religion, just walk them through the Scriptures; tell them what Jesus said. The truth will set them free.
- g. Then you can guide them to Acts 4: 12, and say, "Look what

the Word says here: Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

- h. Then, take them to Revelation 3:20: *Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.*
 - i. Then you tell them, "Jesus is knocking at the door of your heart. He wants to come in and forgive you of everything you've ever done wrong. He wants to bury every mistake and every sin of the past. They will all be buried in the deepest part of the ocean.
 - ii. Have you ever done anything wrong in your life?"
 - 1. "Yeah," is almost always the response.
 - iii. "Have you ever sinned? We all have, haven't we?"
 - 1. Notice that you say, "we." Again shake your head, "yes." Make them feel like you understand and you're in agreement with them. "Yes, we've all fallen short of God's glory."
 - iv. You continue, "But Jesus is knocking at the door of your heart." See how easy it is? Go on and say, "Today, you are opening the door of eternity. Today is the most important day of your whole life! Today, you can open up the door and ask Jesus to come in."



- . As you start your day, say, "Lord, make me a soul winner. Send whoever you want to bring across my path today that I'm supposed to lead to Jesus...I want to be an instrument for You.
- B. If you make yourself available to Jesus, the Holy Spirit will go before you and convict them. It will become a "piece of cake!"
 - a. You can even say to the person, "Now, put your hand on your heart and go like this." (Then, you show them by placing your hand on your own heart, making a door-opening sound, and pulling your hand in an outward direction from your heart.)
 - i. Ask them, "What are you doing? You are opening the door to your heart, aren't you?" Shake your head in agreement again. You've just made it simple for them to receive Jesus.
 - b. The Devil is a Liar!
 - i. The devil will try to make it sound difficult. He'll say you have to go to Bible school to win souls. He will suggest that it is not your job or duty to win souls but insist that it is the job of the pastor, missionary, or evangelist. The devil will try to put doubt, fear, and intimidation on you. Don't believe him!

Chapter Three

Proclaim the Gospel – And the Holy Ghost Will Do the Rest!

- A. Our part is to proclaim the Gospel.
 - a. We bring the Word; the Holy Spirit is responsible to convict them.
 - i. He will not only convict them, but create within them a desire for what you are sharing with them.
- B. To do our part, we need both the Word (the Bible) and the Holy Spirit.

"So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it"

(Isaiah 55:11)

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

- C. If you really want the Holy Spirit's anointing to be upon you, you must also have God's compassion and burden for souls.
 - a. The Holy Spirit will impart a message of faith to win souls as He sees you seeking, crying, praying, fasting, and yearning for souls
 - b. Learn to "tune-in" to what the Holy Spirit is saying while you are talking with someone.
 - i. The Spirit will enlighten your thoughts and your mind.
 - ii. That's when you learn to start exercising that knowledge of the Word in you.
 - 1. The Spirit will show you which Scriptures to use.
 - c. God maneuvers circumstances to bring opportunities for us to witness.
 - 1. God will cause you to be at the right place at the right time, and actually use the circumstances of a particular situation to bring a witnessing opportunity.

ACTION STEP

D. Study John 3:1-17. Get this down so well in your spirit that you can use it wherever you are to minister to the lost. This is the story about Nicodemus in the Bible (see next page).

E. This is a good Scripture portion to illustrate to people who think they are going to Heaven because they are good. Then, you can show them

NOTES

The Compassion of God Precedes the Power of God

- A. Before Jesus worked the miracles of God, very often in Scripture, it said, "And Jesus was moved with compassion." Faith works by love. Look at the following illustration of God's compassion at work.
 - a. Say out loud with faith: "I am a tool for God. I am His hands, His feet. God wants to use me!"

ACTION STEP

> Our Lord, gracious and full of compassion, sent me to pray for a little girl who was dying with epilepsy. The doctors said that this was the last seizure her body could tolerate. She had lost forty percent of her weight; I could see her bones through her skin.

BUT, I knew that I knew that the power of Jesus was going to touch that little girl!

Friend, you have to remember that you must know that you know that you know that you know that God is going to use you to be a soul winner. It's a piece of cake! Because you are a tool. And, you have the anointing. Greater is He that is within you than the lies of the devil! Don't let the enemy stop you. Get excited! The time is so short. The signs are all around us. Glory to God!

So, the little girl is lying there. I had prayed a prayer that God convicted me never to pray again even though my motive was right. I saw her suffering; she'd had those seizures. She was just a baby, 2 ½ years old. Here, she was in a coma, and I looked at her, crying, "My God, this baby has never seen or will ever see the beautiful ocean which is just a few short blocks away. If you want to, Lord, take half of my health away and give it to this little girl. Let her live. God, don't let her die." She was just beginning her life, and I was already about 30 at that time.

God rebuked me, "Don't pray that way. I already paid the price! I paid the price! Nobody else can pay the price!" Faith was imparted to me, and a bold spirit of anger against the devil rose up inside me.

I laid hands on that sweet little girl and told her family to take her to the doctor to be checked. They had an appointment in Guadalajara the next day because a specialist wanted to see her before she died so he could study her. I prophesied to them, "Your daughter isn't going to die. She is going to live." And, guess what name they gave her that she kept all her years at the school she attended? She was called the "child of the miracles."

Chapter Four

The Compassion of God Precedes the Power of God

- B. Healing and other miracles bring glory to God.
 - a. As Jesus and the disciples in the early church shared the Gospel, they also "cast out devils and healed the sick." Miracles are an exciting part of winning the lost to Jesus!
 - b. But, don't be intimidated by this. It's not you doing the miracle it's the Holy Spirit. All you have to do is yield yourself to be sensitive to His direction...then, be obedient!

And (believers) went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. (Mark 16:20)

- C. In addition to studying and using the Word of God and exercising your faith, you can receive the impartation of God's anointing from men and women of God who are moving in the operation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit.
 - a. If you are present at a soul-winning seminar, I will be praying for those who attend. I will ask God to impart the soul-winning and miracle anointing to them by the Spirit of God to each and every one who is available.
 - b. Seek out men and women of God who operate in the power of God and ask them to pray for you.
- D. Winning souls can have a multiplication and geometric effect. You may win one soul who turns out to be a great evangelist who wins thousands of more souls, or that one soul may just witness in their own sphere of influence and win the souls of the people he meets on a daily basis.
 - a. In either case, you will receive a reward from God for all of those fruits because of the souls you have won to the Lord. Praise God!
 - b. Always remember, the people you lead to Jesus need follow-up.
 - i. A Bible-teaching church with uncompromised preaching and Christian fellowship.
 - ii. Study the Bible. (You may want to buy them one if they don't already have a Bible.)
 - iii. Prayer as daily communion with God.

- A. Faith is the foundation of everything we are and everything we do, and winning souls is no exception.
 - a. Your **biggest defense** against every **spiritual attack** is the **Word of God**. Read the following Scripture selection:

¹⁴And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a certain man, kneeling down to him, and saying,

¹⁵Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

- **b.** Here, the disciples were being trained. Jesus showed them how they could heal the sick, cast out devils, raise the dead whatever it was that Jesus did **He said they could do it, too!**
 - i. While they were **out in the marketplace**, the disciples were having a great time **doing the works of Jesus** including casting out devils until they ran into a few obstacles and couldn't get the job done. They came back and asked, "Lord, why couldn't we cast the devil out?"
 - Jesus answered their question, "...because of your unbelief." In verse 20, He went on to tell them:

"... for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you."

- c. A mustard seed of doubt will steal your miracle.
 - i. As big of a miracle as you can receive with a mustard seed of faith, a mustard seed of doubt will steal your miracle!
- d. Can you see how **faith is our ally to winning souls**, while **doubt or unbelief** can **steal the opportunity** or manifestation of the miracle right before it ever happens!
- B. You can't be too proud to obey God in the little things. **Faith** and **obedience** go hand-in-hand.
 - a. Great faith starts out with having faith for the little things.
 - b. When you exercise your faith, it grows into faith for bigger things
 - c. Just speak the Word.
 - i. If faith is in your heart, faith will come out of your mouth.
 - ii. Words of faith will bring forth the things believed.
- C. Timing is critical in the faith walk.
 - a. Brother or sister, if you have a need, don't miss God's timing to meet that need.
 - b. When God imparts faith to you, you must move right then as the Holy Spirit leads you.
- D. A lesson in faith. See the following Scripture:

"... for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you."

Matthew 17:20

- E. What are the principles here that we can learn from this lady with the issue of blood who followed them?
 - a. She **heard the Word** (the message that Jesus heals the sick)
 - b. She believed what she heard FAITH.
 - c. **She ACTED** on that faith by boldly crawling after Jesus.
 - **d.** She **received her miracle!** (Her miracle wasn't handed to her she boldly took it!)
- F. For other examples of these principles in action, read these Scripture portions:
 - a. Blind Bartimaeus (Mark 10:46-52)
 - b. The Roman Centurion (Luke 7:1-10)

Faithfulness and Obedience Create a Favorable Environment and Move the Favorable Hand of God

A. Whatever area you can be faithful in, do it! God will bless you for your faithfulness!

Since I was a little boy, I'll never forget! I took real pride in serving in the House of God. I took pride in blessing missionaries when they came into town. I went deer hunting and fishing. I would have a big bathtub full of fish, and I would tell the missionaries to pick which fish they wanted.

- B. God is obligated to bless you when you've been faithful in the least. Luke 16 shows that if you are faithful in the little things, God will bless you with bigger things.
 - a. It is an honor to serve your pastor and your church. Do not overlook or neglect this privilege. Whatever you do for the House of God will come back to you a hundred times in blessings from God.

One time while I was speaking at a church, I was invited to a lovely dinner. I saw this very sweet lady cooking in the kitchen all by herself. Then, when it came time to wash the dishes, I saw this same kind lady washing the dishes again all by herself – and cleaning up afterward. Who do you think she was? She was the pastor of the church where I had been speaking. She should not have been the one doing all of this by herself.

- b. Also of great importance according to God's Word is to honor, respect, and obey your parents, and God promises that you will have a long and satisfying life!
- C. Do you have great dreams in your heart? Whether it's being in the ministry, climbing the corporate ladder, or raising a son or daughter who will impact the world...you can be sure the starting point is faithfulness.
- D. Do you know that Jesus is coming soon? We must be ready and prepared to meet Him. Even more importantly, we must obey the Great Commission; we must be sure that we have been faithful to make others ready not only by getting them saved, but also by discipling and teaching them to win souls to Jesus.
- E. Have you done everything the Lord has asked of you? None of us have.
 - a. Don't wait one more moment! Repent!

- b. Purpose in your heart that you will be all that God wants you to be!
- c. Tell God today that if He will impart a soul-winning spirit to you right now, you will become immediately available.
- d. Repeat these words out loud. "Lord Jesus, anoint me, my mind, my soul, my heart, and my mouth to be a soul winner today. I will obey You and do it, and I will try not to miss a single opportunity that You send my way."
- e. Be faithful to run the race that He alone has set before you. Remember, someday you will stand before the Lord to give account of how you've spent your life. Will you hear Him say to you, "Well done, good and faithful servant."?
- f. God will promote you in due season.
- F. There are as many ways to serve as there are people. God has placed desires, abilities, and gifts within you to equip you for the special destiny He has planned for you. This is a universal need that people have to feel that they are making a valuable contribution to the world, and that their lives count for the time they spend on earth. What does all this have to do with winning souls?
 - a. First, there is no more important way to be faithful than to bring souls into God's Kingdom.
 - b. Secondly, one effective way to get people talking about God is to share with them that God has a special plan for their lives.
- G. Faithfulness is wisdom. Faithfulness needs to be followed with obedience.
 - a. Matthew 25 shares two famous parables; the first one described ten virgins. Five were foolish and five were wise. What made the five wise? It was their readiness and obedience. They were prepared for when the bridegroom would arrive.
 - b. When it doesn't seem to be working...check to see if there is some area of sin or disobedience in your life. If God reveals something to you, repent, and get your relationship right with Him.
- H. Watch how people answer this question. "Do you believe God CAN heal you?" Almost always the answer is yes. "Do you believe God WANTS to heal you?" Again, yes. "Do you believe God IS GOING TO heal you NOW?" This is where people's faith falters.
- I. You are delivered from your past! Forgive others...forgive yourself, and look to God for the future!

We will come before You, Lord, and pray for our families. We will search for You. We will seek You for our families. And, You will hear us and answer our prayers. We speak to those mountains by faith. With a mustard seed of faith, we speak to those mountains that have bound our families in the days of the past. The mountains will be broken in Jesus' Name. They have to move because the Holy Spirit will move them when we speak the Word!

- E. God is faithful and loves your family even more than you do. He died for them! If you are faithful to love them and intercede for them, God will be faithful to answer your prayers and save them.
- F. Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world! The devil can't steal your husband, your wife, your children, your mom, your dad, or anybody else in your family! Confess that for your family! "The devil can't steal my husband, my wife, my children, my mom, my dad, or anybody else in my family! The devil can't have them. Hallelujah!"

Intercession – Holding Fast to the Promises of God!

- A. After having knowledge of God's Word, living free from sin, and having a good testimony before Jesus, probably, the next most important criteria for becoming an effective soul winner is your prayer life!
- B. I would like to address a subject which has been quite controversial among churches: the baptism of the Holy Spirit. When you are born again, you receive the infilling of the Holy Spirit and the privilege of eternal life in Heaven. This is all you need from the standpoint of salvation. You do receive the Holy Spirit when you receive Christ.
 - a. The subsequent gift of the baptism of the Holy Spirit is a wonderful gift from Christ that is available to those who want it and ask for it.
 - b. The gifts of the Spirit, including speaking with other tongues, are valuable tools in winning souls.
 - i. The baptism of the Holy Spirit opens doors to greater revelation, greater power for witnessing and ministry, and allows you to reach a new level of understanding and effectiveness in intercessory prayer.

And, being assembled together with them, (Jesus) commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence...But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth...

(Acts 1:4-5, 8)

- ii. We don't always know how to pray for people or situations. Praying in the prayer language will get beyond the surface appearance of a situation, and uncover the root causes concerning the problem or need.
- *iii.* Praying in the language of "tongues" helps us to pray effectively without our limited intellectual knowledge getting in the way.

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

(Romans 8:26-27)

Intercession –

Holding Fast to the Promises of God

- iv. Through praying in the Spirit (as evidenced by the manifestation of supernatural "tongues"), we can pray God's perfect will for those people in whose behalf we are interceding as we stand in the gap for their salvation.
- v. Spending time in intercession and the study of God's Word will equip us to minister to the lost. Intercession will also prepare the hearts of the people ahead of time for those divine appointments arranged by the Holy Ghost.
- c. The baptism of the Holy Spirit is a free gift. Just like you received salvation through faith, believe now that you will receive the infilling of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in other tongues as you pray: ACTION

Father, I want all that You have purposed to give to me. Thank you that I am already Your child. Jesus, baptize me now with Your Holy Spirit according to Your Word. I receive this precious gift from You now by faith, and I will speak with other tongues as the Holy Spirit gives me utterance. Thank you, Father. In Jesus' Name.

- C. Praying God's Word is one of the most powerful forms of intercession.
 - a. During your prayer time and whenever doubts try to attack you, speak out the promises in God's Word that fit the need for which you are believing to receive from God.
- D. Bind the influences of evil off those for whom you are interceding in prayer.
- E. As you pray, hold fast to your confession of faith for the salvation of those God places in your path.
- F. Above all, don't give up or get discouraged. Remember, you do have a part in sharing the Gospel with others, but the Holy Spirit is the One who draws them to Christ.
- G. Tools that are good for witnessing include music tapes, DVDs, CDs, books, tracts, and little gifts that share God's Word; i.e., a prayer manual or a particular book on a subject or need close to their heart.
- H. Follow-up with a call, or a visit if possible, once a week or so when witnessing. After they receive Christ, be sure to get them into a Biblebelieving, Spirit-filled church (if possible), or introduce them to a pastor or another Christian who will disciple them.



Scriptures to Study and Memorize

NOTE: These are some suggested Scriptures to use when sharing the plan of salvation with people who need Jesus. You can read them from the Bible, and show the person where they are located. But, it's also good to memorize the Scriptures for easy recall when you are talking with someone...at least a few of them. You won't always have a lot of time to talk with a person, but will still want to leave them with at least a Scripture or two. (NOTE: The following Scriptures are taken from the NKJV – New King James Version – of the Holy Bible.)

...even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved). (Ephesians 2:5)

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God. (Ephesians 2:8)

This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief... who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. (1 Timothy 1:15)

...who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. (1 Timothy 2:4)

And they were greatly astonished, saying among themselves, "Who then can be saved?" (Mark 10:26)

And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end shall be saved. (Mark 13:13)

...by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. (1 Corinthians 15:2)

There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death. (Proverbs 14:12)

And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, (Hebrews 9:27)

And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness,[a] for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses." (Luke 12:15)

For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? (Mark 8:36)
